Amount: \$150
Eligibility: Northeast High students
Criteria: Vocal student, major in vocal music or attend summer camp, financial need

DESCRIPTION: This scholarship was established in memory of Duane Nichols, who was a vocal music teacher at Lincoln Northeast High School from 1969 to 1992. The importance of the student as a person was paramount in his teaching. He believed the musical opportunities available provide valuable experiences for students. This \$150 scholarship will be given to a Northeast High School vocal student.

PURPOSE: To provide an opportunity for a Northeast vocal student, with a proven interest in music, to attend a summer music camp or for college expenses if the student plans to major in vocal music. Financial need will be considered. The scholarship will be paid directly to the camp.

TO APPLY: Submit an application form (available in music room or counseling center and also included herein on the following page). Submit typed essay (not more than one page) telling how music has affected your life and how you expect to use music throughout your life.

Submit completed applications to Northeast High School Counseling Center.

SELECTION COMMITTEE: The scholarship recipient will be selected by the Foundation for Lincoln Public Schools with recommendations from the Northeast Concert Choir Director, an Associate Principal of Northeast High School, and two members of the Vocal Boosters.

DEADLINE: The scholarship application deadline is March 15.

AWARD: The recipient of the award will be announced by the Concert Choir Director at the vocal award ceremonies in May.
